Advising for undergraduate BBA students on probation

- All undergraduate students on probation in the BBA programs will have to go through separate counselling and advising sessions to be held on **September, 4,7,8,9,10, and 11, 2014.**
- Students on probation must be accompanied by their guardian(s) in order to complete their counselling and advising.
- Failure to go through counselling and advising at the appointed time will automatically result in blocked IDs and dropped semester (Fall 2014).
- Look up your advising appointment from the **BBA advising schedule (Revised)**. Be present at the advising centre 15 minutes before the scheduled time.

Note:

- All probation students **MUST** be accompanied by one or both of their guardians to complete the counselling and advising process. Students, who fail to bring their guardian(s) to the advising session, whatever the reason, will not be advised under any circumstances.
- You **MUST** report on time for your scheduled appointment. **NO** late advising will be allowed.
