Important instructions for degree candidates

20th Convocation 2017 of NSU will be held on April 9, 2017 (Sunday) at NSU Bashundhara Campus. **Mr. Nurul Islam Nahid**, MP, The Hon'ble Minister, Ministry of Education, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh will confer the degree to the graduating students. **Prof. Abdul Mannan**, Chairman, University Grants Commission of Bangladesh will be present as the Special Guest. **H.E. Mikael Hemniti Winther**, Ambassador, Royal Danish Embassy, Bangladesh will be present as Convocation Speaker.

- Convocation gowns and invitation cards distribution started on April 4, 2017 and will continue till April 7, 2017 at the Auditorium Lounge

- Those who have not yet received the **invitation card** are advised to collect the invitation and dinner cards on April 7, 2017, Friday between 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. from the Auditorium Lounge.
- For procession assembly, all registered graduate must enter NSU campus by **8:30 A.M.** through SAC or NAC entrance on the day of Convocation (Sunday, April 9, 2017).
- Procession Assembly Registered graduates are advised to enter the designated room for
 procession assembly (see your room and serial on the web). Please follow the procession
 serial and instruction of ushers precisely. Link:

- Do not forget to bring your invitation card on the Convocation day.
- Student procession will start sharp at 9:00 A.M.
- MAKE SURE THAT YOU ENTER THE CAMPUS BEFORE 9:00 A.M. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE CAMPUS AFTER 9:00 A.M.
- In addition to student volunteers there will be **Faculty Members** to assist the graduates and their parents/guardians/guests.
- The parents/guardians/guests will be sitting separate from the graduating students. Ushers will help them. Ask your parents/guardians to follow the instruction of the ushers.
- The refreshments will be served just after the first session of the convocation ceremony (approx. at 12:00 p.m.). On the Convocation Day, there will be **NO** food available in the campus. (light snacks/drinks might be available at the NAC & SAC 2nd floor).
- Please maintain the discipline and follow the instruction of the ushers. Remember the Convocation Ceremony is a very formal program and the Hon'ble Education Minister will be there.
- Second part i.e. Certificate distribution will start at 12:30 P.M. from following venues:
 - 1. Plaza area- School of Business & Economics (SBE)- 12:30 P.M-
 - 2. **Central Auditorium** School of Health & Life Sciences (**SHLS**)- 12:30 P.M.-2:00 P.M)
 - 3. Central Auditorium- School of Engineering & Physical Sciences (SEPS)- 2:00P.M.-3:30 P.M

- 4. AUDI-801- School of Humanities & Social Sciences (SHSS)- 12:30 P.M.-
- You'll be given your procession serial number during the procession assembly. You <u>HAVE TO</u> maintain the same serial number during the certificate distribution session. Please remember your serial number and queue in the line accordingly.
- For each graduating student, maximum **2 guests** are allowed for convocation ceremony and convocation dinner.
- Guests <u>MUST</u> also bring the invitation card for the above programs.
- Dinner will be served at around 7:30 p.m. Designated dinner venues are:
 - 1. Upper deck- Open Gallery area
 - 2. Study Hall (Library)
 - 3. Auditorium Lobby
 - 4. Exhibition Hall (Ground level of Auditorium)
- Please **DO NOT** forgets to bring the dinner cards for you and your guests.
