Advising will be in three phases as before. The procedure remains the same except for the probation students.

- 1. Pre-advising and faculty evaluation is mandatory for phase 1
- 2. All payments must be clear by January 1st to be considered for phase 1
- 3. There could be slots for all including probation students but advising could be conditional
- 4. Probations 2 and above will be handled by the corresponding department separately.
- 5. Reasons for disqualification from advising:
 - Missing pre-advising
 - Payment is due
 - Payment was not complete by January 1st, 2023
 - Missing faculty evaluation
 - > Student missed advising for 2 or more consecutive semesters without permission
 - Unauthorized Semester Drop

Phase 1 - Pre-advised Based advising: (Jan 15, 2023 – Jan 17, 2023)

- 1. Advising will be based on students' pre-advising courses.
- 2. Student can add, drop and change section accordingly.
- 3. Every student will have two slots for the day.
- 4. Any student who is missing a slot can advise in phase 2 and in phase 3

Phase 2 - Slot less advising (Jan 18, 2023 – Jan 19, 2023)

- 1. There are no pre-fixed slots in this phase unlike Phase 1. It's an equal opportunity for all. A dynamic slot could be imposed if the student number exceeds a limit.
- 2. Pre-advising restriction will be removed. All courses will be visible to all students
- 3. Student can add, drop and section change

Phase 3 – Drop less advising (Jan 24, 2023 – Jan 28, 2023)

- 1. The system will remain open for all students
- 2. Course drop is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Section change is allowed
- 4. Advising ends on Jan 28, 2023
