Probation Student Advising – Spring 2023

The probation policy followed in the pre-pandemic period (Spring 2020 and before) has been reactivated from Spring 2023 and onwards.

All Probation Students

- 1. They must complete their pre-advising, faculty evaluation irrespective of their probation count
- 2. The advising is conditional from phase 1.

Probation 1

- 1. These students will get a warning message right after the grade submission. 09/01/2023
- 2. Do not need to bring parents or give undertaking for this semester
- 3. Advising is allowed automatically from phase 1 starting from January 15, 2023

Probation 2

- 1. Students will get a message right after the final grade submission.
- 2. Must bring their parents when meeting the Chair.
- 3. A yellow undertaking must be signed.
- 4. The Chair will authorize the student for self advising in the system
- 5. The student may get an SMS confirmation
- 6. The Chair may optionally prescribe courses for the students. These prescribed courses will hide the pre-advised courses and the student will only see the prescribed courses in the actual advising.
- 7. At this stage, student is ready to do self advising as per the schedule published.

Probation 3

- 1. Students will get a message right after the final grade submission
- 2. Must bring their parents when meeting the Chair
- 3. A light red undertaking must be signed.
- 4. Department chair will authorize the student for self advising in the system
- 5. The student may get an SMS confirmation
- 6. The Chair may optionally prescribe courses for the students. These prescribed courses will hide the pre-advised courses and the student will only see the prescribed courses in the actual advising.
- 7. At this stage, student is ready to do self advising as per the schedule published.

Probation 4 and above

- 1. A special meeting will be held to revew these cases right after the final grade submission
- 2. Eligible students can expect a message to meet their respective Chair.
- 3. These students must bring their parents when meeting the department Chair
- 4. A dark red undertaking must be signed by the Students and the Parents.
- 5. Department chair will authorize the student for self advising in the system
- 6. The student may get an SMS confirmation
- 7. The Chair may optionally prescribe courses for the student. These prescribed courses will hide the pre-advised courses and the student will only see the prescribed courses in the actual advising.
- 8. At this stage, student is ready to do self advising as per the schedule published.
