

Probation Student Advising – spring 2019

Probation student advising schedule is the same as the regular student but with a condition. These students will be provided with an advising slot like any other regular student based on their credit completed, CGPA and seniority. Their advising is conditional upon the meeting with their respective chair.

Here is the process

1. Probation student advising schedule will be published along with the regular students.
2. These students must complete their undertaking and meeting with their chair before being eligible for advising.
3. Probation 2 and 3 must bring their parents to meet the chair. Probation 1 student does not need parents but they must complete their undertaking.
4. The student must follow the advising schedule and must complete the undertaking before the advising schedule in order to avoid missing the advising slot.
5. The student will be confirmed by an SMS when he/she is all cleared for advising by the chair.
6. Every probation student will be provided with three slots like any other regular students.
7. The missing advising can only be accommodated in phase 2 and in phase 3

Probation 4 and above: Decision Pending.
