

NSU faculty member has been nominated for prestigious Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting

Dr. Mahdy Rahman Chowdhury (Associate Professor, ECE Department, North South University) has been nominated by the TWAS, The World Academy of Sciences, for participation in the 70th Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting - from 28 June to 3 July 2020.

Up to 80 Nobel Laureates and ‘finally selected’ 600 highly-talented young scientists from all over the world will participate in this prestigious meeting. For every meeting, over a thousand young candidates are primarily nominated. Congratulations to Dr. Mahdy who is now one of them (primary 1000)!
